LEAN Six Sigma Course

The training on "Lean Six Sigma Green Belt for Executives" started on Sept 20, 2016. The candidates, from different industries, including biotechnology, pharmaceuticals, insurance, consumer goods, engineering, will meet over the course of next 5 weeks to learn the fundamentals of Lean Six Sigma, and the application of this methodology to eliminate wasteful activities, standardize processes and increase customer satisfaction. Prof. Gurpreet Singh is delivering the training through a combination of lectures and group activities, where the students will learn key Lean Six Sigma tools such as business process mapping, affinity diagrams, root-cause analysis and solution planning.
